December 13, 2016: President Obama Signs 21st Century Cures Act into Law



#### **Identify the Problems**



- More women with chronic conditions are becoming pregnant.
- 90% of pregnant women take at least one medication, with 70% taking at least one prescription drug during pregnancy.<sup>1</sup>
- There is a lack of robust information on the safety and efficacy of many drugs across the continuum from pregnancy through breastfeeding.<sup>2</sup>
- Without reliable data, women may decide to stop taking necessary medications, not to initiate breastfeeding or wean earlier than desired.
- We need better and more information.
- How can the community impact this issue?


