

Why a Functional Reorganization?

YEARS OF INNOVATION

- Associate Director, Division of Extramural Research manages a high number of direct reports and level of assets
- Need career development opportunities for <u>all</u> extramural staff.
- Coordination and overview of specific programs is required (e.g., clinical trials, SBIR)
- Need ability to provide back-up to programs when large, unexpected events occur or emergencies happen
- Plan for succession

Functional Analysis (February to May 2020)

• Process to identify the needs and requirements in the structure, function, and staffing of the Division of Extramural Research (DER)



Organizational Structure Review (May to October 2020)

• Determine if the structure and staffing of DER was optimal to meet the needs identified in the functional analysis




Proposed Structure and Decision (November 2020)

• Meetings with leadership to review proposal for organizational structure and branch renaming where proposed






















